Zora Folley Stops Brown, TKO In 9th

Zora Folley, inexperienced but promising, won his first professional fight in Arizona Tuesday night when he stopped K. O. Brown of Los Angeles at the start of the ninth round.

The end would have come much sooner except that the Chandler heavyweight listened to his corner slowing him down to make sure he lasted the whole way in his first 10-round main event.

Folley, who weighed 188, was way ahead on points when Brown, 195, quit at the end of the eighth, declaring he couldn't move and that an overnight auto trip had contributed to his condition.

FOLLEY, A SMART stand-up boxer with considerable power, did his share too. He had Brown staggered in the first and second rounds and undoubtedly would have ended the bout much earlier but for his corner's advice to take it easy. He apparently was not too much bothered by Brown's unorthodox style, a wide-swinging attack with crouching, grabbing, and backing away much in evidence.

Folley's corner told him to cut loose with everything in the ninth. Brown must have heard that. He had slowed in the seventh and eighth as Folley began mixing in an occasional shot to the body with his usual hooks, jabs, and straight rights to the head.
